*All freshmen in the Honors College will be assigned to live in Griffis, Nunnelee or Hurst Hall for their first year. If you are a commuter and your home address is within **30 miles** of campus, an exemption can be requested from Mississippi State's Office of Housing and Residence Life. If there is another compelling reason for you not being part of the Honors residential college community, please describe below. Please note that if you wish to live outside of the Honors College halls, you must seek prior approval from the Honors College prior to the April 1 housing priority deadline. Please be aware that if you request and are approved for an Honors housing exemption after the April 1 deadline, you will not be able to select a space to live elsewhere until all freshmen with a timeslot have selected their space.*

To request a non-Honors roommate before the April 1 housing priority deadline, you first must mutually confirm one another on the MSU Housing application. The MSU Housing Office will make every effort to assign the two of you together in Nunnelee or Hurst Hall, but these requests are not guaranteed and will only be honored if space allows. After April 1, you and your non-Honors roommate will need to email your roommate requests (emails from each are required to ensure the requests are mutual) to housing@saffairs.msstate.edu. These requests will also only be honored if space allows.

A committee will review your request and inform you as soon as possible by email.
